The Curriculum: Winnebago Lutheran Academy's integrated and interdisciplinary approach to learning helps students comprehend the broad connections between and among subjects while learning in-depth information in each academic discipline, all in a Christ-centered learning environment. Courses across the curriculum emphasize writing, critical thinking and analysis, technology use and research, collaborative and cooperative learning, with a multicultural focus. Science courses accentuate laboratory work, and math courses focus on problem solving. Upper level language courses rely on original texts. In addition, multiple courses not offered on campus are offered through the Amazing Grace Virtual Academy (AGVA).

Advanced Placement & Dual Credits: AP Courses offered include AP English Literature & Composition and AP Chemistry; both are taught on campus. AP Environmental Science, AP US History, AP Psychology, AP Statistics, AP Computer Science, are taught in partnership with the online program AGVA. In addition, there are multiple courses offered as dual credit through Bethany Lutheran College.

Youth Apprenticeship: In connection with the Fond du Lac Association of Commerce, high school juniors and seniors are offered the opportunity to participate in the Youth Apprenticeship program. This program allows upperclassmen to prepare for a career while still in high school. It is offered as a one or two year program and combines academic education, occupational instruction and work-based learning. This program helps students develop skills needed for the jobs of tomorrow and helps businesses develop, attract and retain a highly skilled workforce.

Grading Scale: Winnebago Lutheran Academy grades on a letter scale, A+ to F. At the end of each semester, students may earn Honors (3.00-3.49) or High Honors (3.50 and above). Grades are weighted to determine grade point averages. For example, a weighted course will earn an extra point, an “A” counts as a 5.00
